1 WHEREAS, at this time, there is nothing to prevent any of these services
2 from coming into Albuquerque to begin operating; and

3 WHEREAS, the time period that this moratorium is effective will allow the
4 City to consider the appropriate regulatory framework and work with affected
5 stakeholders on legislation applicable to allowing additional services to
6 operate in the City.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL, THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF
8 ALBUQUERQUE:

9 SECTION 1. No new company offering bikeshare or scootershare services
10 is permitted to operate within the City of Albuquerque until the sooner of:

11 a) the passage of six months from the date of adoption of this resolution;
12 or

13 b) legislation regulating bikeshare and scootershare services has been
14 enacted by the City.

15 SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, paragraph, sentence,
16 clause, word or phrase of this resolution is for any reason held to be invalid or
17 unenforceable by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not
18 affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this resolution. The Council
19 hereby declares that it would have passed this resolution and each section,
20 paragraph, sentence, clause, word or phrase thereof irrespective of any
21 provision being declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid.
